# Next School Year 25-26

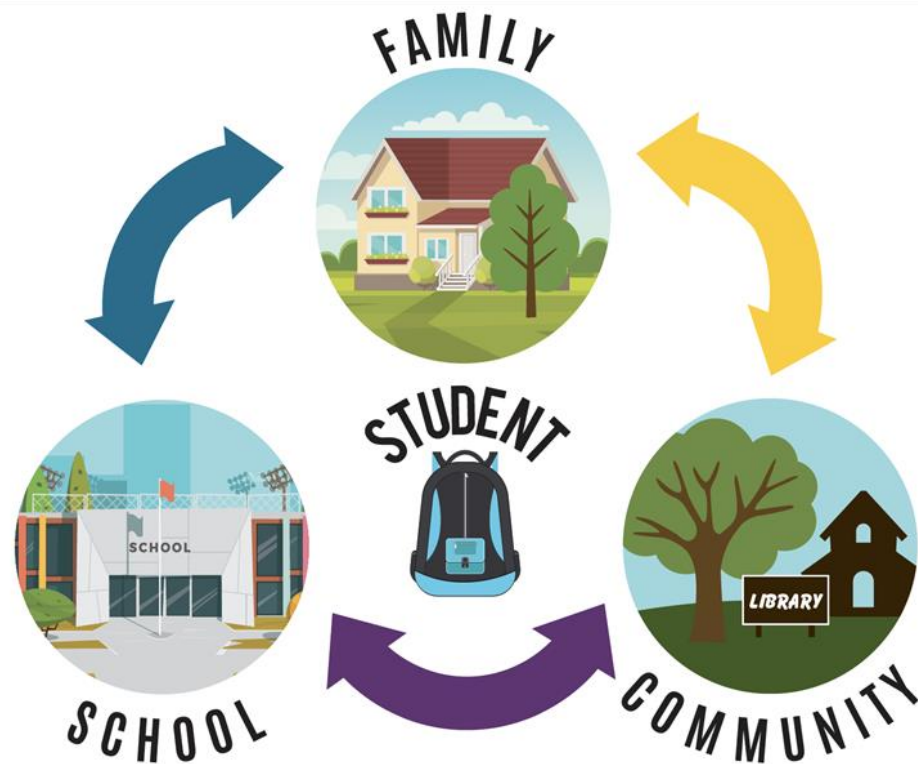
- 5 Special Education Teachers (increase of 1 New Teacher Position)

## **Grow with Purpose and Stability**

Expand to three full cohorts per grade while maintaining the school's core values and diverse identity in 3 years by School Year 2027 - 2028

## **Empower Families as Partners in Learning**

Engage families as essential contributors to student success. Promote three actionable commitments: daily attendance, learning support at home, and volunteering in meaningful ways to strengthen the bridge between home and school.

- 85% parent satisfaction

## **Grow with Purpose and Stability**

- Meet our enrollment yearly goals
- Expand to 3 full cohorts for grades 4 and grade 5 by SY 2027 – 2028

- Come to school everyday – 94% or higher daily attendance
- 85% of families report that they can support learning support at home
